CHANGES TO WASTE MANAGEMENT IN STEWART

Update November 2018



The Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine (RDKS) will be managing solid waste in Stewart in collaboration with the District of Stewart.

The management of household recyclable materials will transfer from Border Town Recycling to the RDKS. Border Town will no longer be a collection depot for household recyclable materials but will continue a program for collection of deposit beverage containers.

Effective December 1, 2018, the

Regional District will collect recyclables (listed below) at the Recycling Diversion Center, located at the Stewart Landfill (future Stewart Transfer Station). The Regional District will be working closely with Border Town to provide public education and continue the successful program they've been operating.

In the spring of 2019, the Stewart Landfill will be fully closed, and the site will be converted to a Transfer Station. The RDKS will manage the landfill closure, construction of the Transfer Station facility and implementation of solid waste programs and services. Stay tuned for more information in the spring.



Starting December 1, 2018, please bring your clean, segregated recyclable materials to the RECYCLING DIVERSION CENTER at the Stewart Landfill

Materials accepted at the Recycling Diversion Center include:

- Plastic containers
- Foam packaging (Styrofoam)
- Paper, paper packaging and cardboard
- Steel and aluminum containers
- Non-deposit glass jars and bottles
- Plastic bags and overwrap
- Tires (off-rim)
- Smoke alarms and CO₂ detectors
- Small appliances and power tools
- Household electronics
- Batteries (under 5 kg) and cell phones
- Light bulbs and fixtures
