

DISTRICT OF STEWART

BYLAW NO. 867-2013

A bylaw to delegate authority to the Chief Administrative Officer to carry out duties related to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act

WHEREAS Section 154(1) of the Community Charter, being Chapter 26, RSBC 1996, provides for Council to delegate certain duties to members of its staff, and

WHEREAS Section 66 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, being Chapter 165, RSBC 1996, provides for the head of a public body to delegate to any person any duty, power or function of the head of the public body except the power to delegate under this section, and

WHEREAS Council, as head of the District of Stewart, is desirous of providing an efficient process for dealing with applications by persons in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, now

THEREFORE the Council of the District of Stewart in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

CITATION:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "The Delegation of Authority under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act Bylaw No. 867-2013."

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

2. The Chief Administrative Officer for the District of Stewart is hereby delegated the authority to perform any duty, power or function assigned to the head of the District of Stewart under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act except for the power to delegate this authority.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS


3. The Chief Administrative Officer will immediately inform Council of all applications received under this legislation, and as soon as possible of actions taken, and of the results of said actions.
