BYLAW # 879 - 2014

BEING A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A CONSERVATION FUND SERVICE.

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Community Charter*, Council may establish any service that council deems necessary or desirable;

AND WHEREAS the Council wishes to establish a service for the purpose of establishing a Conservation Fund in the District of Stewart by collecting \$10.00 per folio of land annually;

AND WHEREAS Council is desirous of establishing this fund to defray maintenance and improvement costs of the Boardwalk, Raine Creek Nature Trail and all parks and greenways;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Stewart, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Citation

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "District of Stewart Conservation Fund Service Bylaw # 879, 2014 "
2. The District of Stewart hereby establishes a service for the purpose of establishing a Local Conservation Fund.

Objects

3. The primary objective of the Conservation Fund shall be to preserve, improve and enhance the Boardwalk, Raine Creek Nature Trail and all parks and greenways.
4. Form a Conservation Fund Committee that will advise Council on proposed improvements or enhancement projects.
5. The Conservation Fund Committee will be comprised of the following:
 - o 1 member from the District of Stewart Council
 - o 1 member from the District of Stewart Management Team
 - o 3 members of the electorate
6. The District of Stewart is responsible for maintaining the integrity of the Fund and retains the responsibility for final approval of all matters related thereto.
7. If there are no projects in any given year the fund will be carried forward to future years.
