

2017 Christmas Card Competition

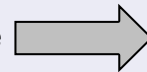
Stewart has so many talented photographers and artists in town, the District of Stewart would like to showcase those in our community with this gifted skill!

2017 Christmas Card Competition Criteria



DEADLINE: Friday October 13, 2017 at 4:30pm



There will be ONE winner selected in each of the following 3 categories:

1. Professional
2. Youth Amateur (under 18 yrs of age)
3. Adult Amateur (18 or over)

Final Results:

- 50 District Christmas Cards will be printed with your design and acknowledge your name on the back of the cards;
- Winning entries will be displayed on the District website and Facebook page throughout the month of December
- The winning entrant will receive 10 of the Christmas Cards with their design

Eligibility:

1. Entrant must be a resident of Stewart;
2. Must be a photograph taken by the entrant or original artwork designed by the entrant;
3. The photo or artwork must be distinctly "Stewart" but may be of any content (ie: nature, wildlife, events, people). *If people are included in a photo it is your responsibility to ensure that they have agreed to have their picture released;*
4. Entrants can submit only one of each type under the same category (ie one photo and one original artwork);
5. Maximum of 2 entries by any one entrant but must be in the same category (cannot submit under both professional and amateur)
6. Entry must be received at the District office by 4:30 pm October 13th, 2017
7. Entrants name, address and phone number printed on the back of the entry.

Judging:

1. Judging will be done without the entrant's name displayed;
2. If there are a large number of entries in any one category, administration will choose the best 10 to submit for final judging;
3. Council will choose the winners at the Council meeting October 23rd;
4. If there are no entries in a category Council may decide to choose another winner from the existing entries.
