



Notice to All Travellers Requesting Clearance to Canada Between Midnight – 08:00 hrs Pacific Standard Time

All persons requesting entry into Canada at the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) Stewart, British Columbia Port of Entry (POE), between the hours of midnight and 08:00 hrs Pacific Standard Time must stop and report by telephone.

In accordance to the *Customs Act*, every person and/or goods entering Canada must be reported. CBSA Officers are authorized to ask questions to the degree necessary to ascertain a person's admissibility and to ensure that all goods being imported are properly declared.

- 1. When reporting by phone: Please ensure you are in possession of all the valid travel documents for all occupants along with your vehicle's license plate number at the time of crossing.**
- 2. Proceed to the telephone reporting system located on the outside wall of the building and pick up the phone receiver. Once the phone begins to ring, stay on the line until a border services officer answers.**
- 3. When speaking with the officer, should you and the other occupants be requested to wait, replace the receiver, proceed to the "Waiting Zone" and remain in your vehicle until otherwise instructed.**
- 4. If the phone line is inoperable, please return to the United States and contact the Beaver Creek POE at 867-862-7230, or return to the Stewart POE at 08:00 hrs.**
