Polystyrene Reduction Program

Program Purpose and Goals

The District of Stewart is implementing a Polystyrene Reduction Program to financially support businesses who voluntarily choose to reduce the use or availability of single use items such as foam plates, bowls, cups and takeout containers.

The Program

Any purchaser of polystyrene products for use in Stewart (ie restaurant, store, event organizer) may apply for funding under this program to help offset the additional cost of purchasing paper or other non-polystyrene products to reduce the use of these products in Stewart. This can also be used to help offset the cost of equipment (ie commercial dishwasher) to eliminate the use of single-use products.

How to Apply

- 1. Obtain the complete guide to determine eligibility**
- 2. Fill out an application before September 30, 2018**
- 3. Once approved—purchase the supplies or equipment**
- 4. Submit claim report with receipts before December 31, 2018**
