Part of the process for obtaining a Primary Liquor License includes obtaining public comment on the application. Prior to the Council for the District of Stewart providing a resolution/comment on the application to the Liquor Control Board it must consider the following:

- The impact of noise on nearby residents.
- The impact on the community if the application is approved.
- The views of residents and a description of the method used to gather views.
- The District's recommendation (including whether or not the application be approved) and the reasons on which they are based.

The application may be viewed at the District office during regular working hours.
