



# Call for Nominations

## 2016 Volunteer Recognition Award

Given annually, the Volunteer Recognition Award will recognize those outstanding volunteers whose unselfish and dedicated service to an organization has made a significant difference in the community.

The District of Stewart may award one Volunteer Recognition Award each year to a deserving individual. Volunteer contributions are demonstrated by results achieved in leadership roles and/or positions, such as committees, task forces, teams, special projects and similar initiatives.

***All nominees must meet the following criteria:***

- Have carried out volunteer (unpaid) activities for 1 or more years

**Call for Nominations**

There are 2 nomination processes: one through a general call for nominees, and one from the DOS staff and Council through their consultations. This dual process recognizes that contributions are made through both the DOS Office and local member-driven initiatives.

**Nomination Process**

In a letter describe the accomplishment(s) for which the individual has been nominated and the impact he or she has had on the community.

**Nominators and References**

Each nomination requires two nominators.

**The Award**

Persons selected for the Volunteer Recognition Award receive:

- Volunteer Recognition Award plaque presented at Council Special Meeting
- Profile on the DOS website
