### QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day (Jan 13, 2024)
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months (June 15, 2023) immediately before the day nomination papers are filed (Dec 15, 2023), and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

### CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS
