IF YOU EXPERIENCE BROWN WATER, PLEASE RUN YOUR WATER FOR A PERIOD OF TIME UNTIL IT RUNS CLEAR.

HERE ARE SOME GUIDELINES TO FOLLOW:

- Turn on a cold water tap and let it run for a few minutes. An outside tap or a laundry tap is preferable and the aerator (a fine mesh grid) on your tap should be removed. Once the water runs clear, the aerator can be placed back on the tap.
- Do not flush from a tap that has a water filter connected to it, as this may cause sediment to clog your filter.
- Do not flush from a hot water tap as sediment could be flushed into your hot water tank.
- To test if the water is running clear, fill a glass with water to see if there is sediment in the water.
