



PUBLIC NOTICE

Bylaw Enforcement Officer

District of Stewart now has a full time Bylaw Enforcement Officer and as part of that position will be concentrating on enforcing some key issues in the coming months. The Objective is to improve the appearance and safety of properties in the District and promote a respectful place to live among residence.

Unsightly Premises

Any residence that is deemed to be in contradiction of the **Unsightly Premise Bylaw No. 672-1996**. This includes Garbage/Disused Materials, Derelict Vehicle and Trailers (I.E., cars, trucks, boats, RV's and ATV's), Graffiti, and Unused Scrap Material (metal, wood, appliances, etc.)

Abandoned Structures and Unsafe Buildings

Any property with abandoned structures or unsafe buildings Shall be dealt with by owners in accordance with the **Building Regulations Bylaw No. 843, 2010** to facilitate the removal of unsightly premises for the safety and benefit of the community.

Solid Waste Collection

Residence shall be aware of regulations regarding solid waste / garbage collection and use of community bins see **Solid Waste Bylaw No. 875, 2015**. Please review unacceptable materials and that all garbage in community bins must be placed inside of bin and not outside of bin. Any garbage placed outside of bins may be considered as unauthorised dumping/littering.

Dog Licensing, Control, and Barking

Owners of canines in the District of Stewart shall adhere to **Animal Control Bylaw No. 815-2006**. This includes having your dog licensed with the district office, not to be at large, chase, attack or bite a person or animal. As well not to be allowed to howl, bark, or cry where likely to disturb persons in the neighborhood or vicinity. This can also be related to **Noise Control Bylaw No. 967, 2020**.

Laneways

Laneways to properties shall be kept free from use of parking vehicles, gardens, and accessory building sites. Laneways are for secondary means to access lots and for District infrastructure. Public Works will have right of access if the need for maintenance of utilities should arise.
