Register Your Household for Stewart's "One Call System"

The District of Stewart has an established emergency phone service with One Call Now.

In the event of an emergency, (i.e. Tsunami warning, flood risk, evacuation, etc.) residents of Stewart will receive a phone call with a recorded emergency message advising of the situation and actions to take. This enables the entire community to receive the message within minutes.

Whether you are new to town, a current resident, would like to add your cell phone number or are wanting *to ensure you are on the call list*, please contact the District office at (250) 636-2251 and staff will verify the records are updated with your current information—for the safety of you and your family.



One Call Now

Collection of Personal Information: One Call Now collects personal information for the purpose of notifying individuals of emergency communications.

Storage Outside of Canada: the information you submit will be stored in or accessed from a location outside of Canada. By signing up for this service, you consent to the information you enter being stored in, or accessed from, a location outside of Canada, and that this permission takes effect immediately. You may withdraw your consent at any time by unsubscribing to the service.
