STEWART BEAUTIFICATION – UNSIGHTLY PREMISES

Beautification of Our Community is One of Council's Priorities

As part of this objective, the District will be cleaning up District-owned properties and ask that residents and property owners with unsightly premises also assist by cleaning up their properties.

We are looking at options to aid in the removal of derelict vehicles, but there are some areas where you can help with overall clean-up.

- Refuse can be taken to the transfer station;
- Overgrown grass and shrubs can be cut and trimmed;
- Broken windows can be repaired.

Unsightly Premises Bylaw No. 672, 1996 regulates untidy and unsightly premises; requiring owners or occupiers of property to remove accumulation of filth, discarded materials, or rubbish of any kind. Failure to clean up unsightly premises may result in financial penalties.

Residents are asked to have their premises cleaned by June 30, 2020; failing which, the District may pursue clean-up and charge back costs to the property owner in addition to any fines.
