THE DISTRICT OF STEWART is seeking applications for a Full Time Heavy Equipment Operator (winter term position).

Location:

With a population of 500, the District of Stewart is a deep-sea port on BC's beautiful northern coast. Stewart is a major tourist draw with its closeness to Alaska and road access to a major glacier – the Salmon. You'll enjoy recreational opportunities year-round with fishing down the Portland Canal, and first-class snowmobiling and heliskiing on the adjacent mountains. Major industry in the area includes mining, logging, tourism, and port operations.

Duties:

Under the direction of the Director of Operations, the Heavy Equipment Operator is responsible for the safe and efficient operation of heavy mobile equipment (Graders, Loaders, Plow Trucks, etc.). The operator will perform rough and fine grade finishing, spreading, and mixing of materials meant for the roadways as well as snow removal from roads and district buildings. Manual duties such as snow removal, sidewalk clearing, ditch drainage maintenance and others as needed, may be assigned. The operator must have strong attention to detail and pride, to complete jobs efficiently and correctly.

Requirements:

- Applicants must be able to legally work in Canada and over 18;
- Class 5, Province of BC, Driver's License with air brakes endorsement; preference will be given to those with a Class 1 or 3 Driver's Licence;
- Grade 12 Education or equivalent;
- Minimum of two years experience in the operation of heavy equipment;
- Proven ability to follow direction, and self motivation to finish tasks and address what needs attention;
- Safe work practices and excellent teamwork skills;
- Experience with public works functions, including roads, water, wastewater and municipal operations considered an asset;
- Experience with the use and maintenance of public works tools and equipment
